June Sawyers, so blond and fair! She's an airline stewardess--she took to the air!

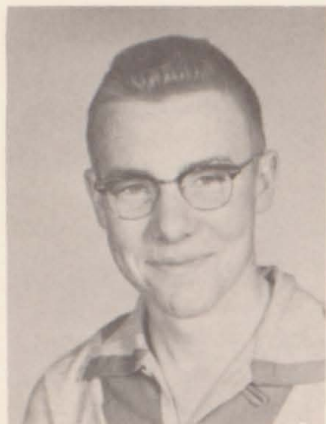
The leading lady of the beauty revue! We're glad to see you, Shirley Sue.
