

## Principal's Message

The first school which was established in 1885, was housed in the basement of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church with students paying tuition and Professor Bass serving as principal. Then it was moved to the ground floor of the Gleason Hotel with Professor Huey as teacher and his wife Julia as the first teacher.

The first public school opened August 27, 1906 with a term of only three months during a year in the Masonic Male and Female Institute which was a two-story brick building erected in 1904 to replace the private school which had burned. In 1925 the town bought the Polk Alexander house and built on the present site. The class of 1929 was the first class to graduate in the new building.

In 1947 the old two-story building, which had been used as a gymnasium since 1932, was torn down and a new gymnasium and six elementary rooms were built. A modern cafeteria, sufficient school bus service, and an intercommunication system have also been added to the school.

Some of the early principals were Birch Atkins, Jack Oliver, Marvin Clark, J. B. White, and W. G. Robinson. Principals since 1920 have been O. B. Holmes, Hugh Hunter, E. L. Freeman, J. B. White, T. D. Ozment, Spencer Taylor, John C. Cook, R. E. Goodgive, James H. Logan, J. E. Choate, Charles V. Butler, J. T. Moore, and Clarence Barham.

Since 1929, 1,318 students have graduated from the Gleason School. The present enrollment of the school is approximately 620.

The 1981-82 school year will probably be one of the most exciting school years in the history of Gleason School. The old two-story high school building built in 1929 will be torn down, and a new modern high school building will be built. The plans call for a new high school built out in front of the old structure and the renovation of the present elementary building and gymnasium. The Weakley County school system has gradually grown toward the top in education and consolidation; an idea Gleason people never liked is a thing of the past.

The 1981-82 year will be remembered as the year of the new school and the good football team. Our boys are having one of the best years ever in the history of Gleason School. The spirit has been higher than any time before. The attitude and cooperation of the students, faculty, and parents has been just great.

For the past fifty years Gleason School has been the heart of our town. We hope that the school will continue to carry on this tradition for the next fifty years.







